Presenters for this year's international conference were selected from submissions presented by some of the highest-ranking music professionals in the world of conducting and will arrive from more than five countries. This year's International Conference will pay tribute to our fallen colleague, Maestro Yuriy Kerpatenko who was murdered by Russian soldiers in his home in Ukraine. Several of Maestro Kerpatenko's female Ukraine conducting colleagues will be attending the conference.

The International Conductors Guild provides high quality conductor training workshops, online job opportunity information, scholastic and educational Journal articles, mentoring for all conductors, online educational lectures in theory and score study, and conferences with some of the orchestra field's leading conductors.
